Residential Permits

The Residential Parking Permit Program has been established to preserve neighborhood living near popular beach locations within the City limits of South Lake Tahoe.

It is designed to provide parking spaces for residents and their guests by discouraging long-term parking by people who do not live in the area.



The Residential Parking Permits are being provided at no cost to residents. Parking Permits are to be displayed in the vehicle when parked on the street.

Parking Program

The City of South Lake Tahoe's Parking Program consists of:

- Beach Parking Kiosks
\$2/hr or a \$10/daily max
- Four-story parking garage
\$3.75/hr or a \$25/daily max
- Residential parking permit program which preserves neighborhood living near popular beach locations
FREE/no cost to residents



PARKING KIOSKS

Beach parking kiosk rates are \$2/hour or a \$10/daily maximum.



** Parking kiosks on Bellamy Court & Transit Way are \$3/hour with a 2 hour maximum time limit.*



Kiosk Locations

Parking Kiosks can be found in several locations in South Lake Tahoe.

Parking Kiosks, or "Pay Stations" are easy to use and accept cash, credit, and debit cards

The rates are \$2/hour or a \$10/daily maximum.

- Bellamy Court & Transit Way
- Paradise Avenue
