For this reason, a screening process is used to evaluate suitability for this program. This screening process is similar to the process used to evaluate suitability for a police ride-along. This screening process includes a check of your official criminal history and a check of your local history with the police department. If you do not wish to comply with this requirement, you should not submit your application.
