Public communications items are limited to 3 minutes and this is the time for members of the public to address the City Council on items not listed on the agenda. Please note however, in accordance with the Brown Act, the City Council cannot deliberate or vote on any matter raised under public communications. Comments for all other scheduled agenda items are also limited to 3 minutes.

The City Clerk will use the meeting timer which will be posted on the white board to the left of the podium. When you are called upon to speak, please come forward to the podium, state your name clearly for the record and we respectfully ask that you keep your comments concise and once the timer ends to please be seated.

Members of the public may submit comments in writing to the City Council relating to any items or City business whether on the City Council agenda or otherwise and such written comments will be distributed to members of the Council.

All written communications received prior to or at the meeting will become part of the permanent record and will be included in the agenda packet and posted on the City's Website.

The City Council asks that respect be shown to the Council, City staff and members of the audience and asks that you please refrain from clapping, booing or shouts of approval or disagreement during the meeting.
