City Recreation Department Partners with Junior Giants

The City of South Lake Tahoe Recreation Department has partnered with the Junior Giants Organization to bring a free baseball program to South Lake Tahoe youth ages 5 to 18 years. City Installs New Ticketless System at Parking Garage

The City of South Lake Tahoe has updated the Heavenly Village parking garage with new parking equipment that relies on license plate recognition and your phone number for entry and exit to the facility.

The new parking system, FLOW Thru Technologies, is a new technology that relies on license plate recognition and your phone number for entry and exit to the facility. The Heavenly Village parking garage will no longer administer access cards for monthly parkers or issue tickets for daily visitors. Printed validations will no longer be used by businesses located in Heavenly Village to validate their customers parking. Instead, businesses will be able to enter your phone number or license plate from their business to provide ticketless validations.

City Installs Electric Charging Station at Heavenly Village Parking Garage




