

We are thrilled and honored that you have chosen to join us for the 4th of July parade!!!!


The response to the parade has been outstanding. We have more than 50 entries in the parade and over 150 walkers.

Red Flag Warnings

South Tahoe Fire Rescue (STFR) implements a program each summer, the Red Flag Warning program. This program helps inform and educate our citizens on when the weather adds to our existing fire dangers. Fire Crews monitor the weather service and when the weather reaches a red flag warning, STFR will implement the following procedures.

- Raise a RED FLAG at each fire station to inform the public.
- Additional personnel to staff a Type 3 (Brush) engine for an aggressive fire attack.
