South Lake Tahoe Bank Robbery Suspect Arrested

South Lake Tahoe, CA (July 1, 2016 9:07pm) - This afternoon, around 12:55pm, a suspect robbed the South Lake Tahoe branch of El Dorado Savings Bank, at 1036 Al Tahoe Boulevard. The suspect demanded money, but displayed no weapon. He fled from the bank with an undisclosed amount of money. SLTPD detectives began investigating immediately with the assistance of the FBI.

The investigation led to the identification of Gabriel Antonio Evans, a 36 year old South Lake Tahoe resident. Detectives secured an arrest warrant for Evans and a search warrant for his residence in the 3000 block of Riverside Avenue. Due to Evan's past violent criminal history, the SWAT team was employed to make the arrest. Officers, assisted by the FBI, arrested Evans at his residence at 7:45pm this evening. The search of Evan's residence is in progress at the time of this news release. Evans has been taken to the police department for further investigation. He will be booked into the El Dorado County Jail on the charge of robbery.
