

## NOAA Forecast

**Weather update from our friends at NOAA.**

**Scenario** -- Isolated storms over the high Sierra this afternoon and tomorrow afternoon, but pushing off to the west fairly quickly. Sunday and Monday are really the days to watch for our region with increased storm coverage, strong outflow winds, and potential for localized flash flooding.

**Impacts/Advice** -- We'll probably see some new fire starts from lightning but slow storm motions and increased moisture Sunday, Monday will mitigate the risk some so we don't plan on any watches/warnings at this time. Fire agencies should still be prepared for increased initial attack if we see enough storms. Strong outflow winds, especially on Sunday, could rapidly spread new fire starts. Also this weather pattern increases the risks of seeing flash flooding on recent burn scars and other flood prone spots. I've whipped up a quick

preparation and response will want to keep an eye on these areas Sunday and Monday.

**Smoke --** We're seeing a lot of haze in the region today and that's largely from fires in Oregon and Idaho. Attached an AlertTahoe camera image. Mt Rose is even obscured some from our office. There's a prevailing northeast flow that will continue through Saturday so I don't expect much change in the haze through then. This of course may impact air quality each day.

### Thunderstorms Sunday/Monday

Scattered slow moving storms with heavy rain are possible both Sunday and Monday afternoons. This could result in flash flooding on recent burn scars. Have a plan if you live or work near these areas.

\* Wetting rain is approximately 0.1 to 0.25 inches of rainfall. This could be enough to trigger flash flooding on burn areas if it falls in a short time period.



## Lobby Upgrades at Lake Tahoe Airport

The City of South Lake Tahoe has several construction projects currently underway at Lake Tahoe Airport. First, we have mechanical and ADA improvements occurring on the interior of the building. The airport building was originally constructed in 1959. The last time the air and heating were upgraded was 40 years ago.

DML Construction was the lowest responsive bidder and therefore was awarded this project. DML Construction has hired six (6) local subcontractors including;

- McGee Plumbing - HVAC/Plumbing/Fireplace
- Champion Floors - Flooring
- Kaczmar Painting - Painting
- Alpine Metals - Structural Steel
- South Shore Glass - Glazing
- Winter's Electric - Electrical

The majority of the funding for this project was derived from the sale of Stream Environment Zone Coverage at the airport property. Per the Federal Aviation Administration regulations, the funds generated from the sale of the coverage must be reinvested at the airport, therefore these funds could not be used on any other capital improvement projects in town. Construction is due to be completed in mid-October.

## Ramp Construction at Lake Tahoe Airport

A portion of the airport ramp is being replaced at Lake Tahoe Airport. The project is called the Ramp Phase 3 reconstruction and is Phase 3 or a 5 Phase project.

During the busy season the entire apron at Lake Tahoe Airport is occupied with aircraft and the larger aircraft are parked on all sections of the apron. The last time the apron was upgraded was in 1984.

Funding for this project is from a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) grant in the amount of nearly \$1.4 million dollars for the Reconstruction of the General Aviation Ramp Phase 3. Another \$50,000 was received from a Caltrans grant. The Ramp Phase 3 construction is due to be completed by the end of September 2016 with the complete project concluding within two years.

## K9 Trials

**September 10th beginning at 9am**

The South Lake Tahoe Police Department K9 Unit will be hosting the 9th Annual K9 Trials on Saturday, September 10th beginning at 9am.

The patrol dog competition will be held at Lakeview Commons at El Dorado Beach with the Field Search phase which tests the ability of the canine team to locate hidden suspects. The Obedience and Agility phases are combined and tests the dogs ability to navigate several obstacles and respond to the handlers commands of right turn, left turn, about turn, turn into your dog, fast/slow and heel.

The final Protection phase will begin at approximately 1pm and judges the canine on their courage, drive, and control. Handlers are sequestered and do not know the scenario until they walk onto the field.


