

Addendum to Temporary Activity Application COVID19 Protocols REQUIRED

As of April 20, 2021 the City of South Lake Tahoe has authorized permitting private and public events that comply with the current California Department of Public Health Guidelines (CDPH). All event applicants are required to submit a written attachment to the standard application outlining public safety protocols consistent with the CDPH published guidelines for their specific activity.

In addition to specific requirements for your event, all events must address:

- 1) Standard Prevention Practices for all attendees including workers
- 2) Protocols for event workers
- 3) Protocols for participants and spectators
- 4) Egress and Ingress plan

Please read the CDPH guidelines carefully to identify capacity limits on number of attendees and any restrictions on geographic location/distance attendees are traveling from.

Please be aware these guidelines are subject to change pending public health conditions and directives from the California Department of Public Health.

Acknowledgment of COVID-19 Requirements for City-Permitted Events and Waiver of Liability

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), El Dorado County Department of Public Health, and California Department of Public Health (CDPH) have developed a number of industry-specific guidelines to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in various settings, one or more of which apply to your event depending on the activities proposed.
