



## Campground Rules

**Our mission is to create a safe and memorable camping experience for all patrons of the campground. Please assist us by complying with the following rules:**

- Check in any time after 1pm – Check out no later than 11am.
- Pets must be restrained and supervised at all times.
- Persistent barking dogs will not be tolerated.
- Quiet time 9 pm to 7 am (including generators) *strictly enforced*.
- By law, firewood may not be collected from the forest or surrounding property.
- The only open flames allowed are in designated fire rings or BBQs for the purpose of recreation, cooking, and warming fires. No other flames are allowed including tiki torches or any kind of sparkler or firework by order of the SLT Fire Chief.
- Seasonal fire restrictions may prevent use of BBQ & campfire ring. When fire restrictions are in place, no charcoal or wood fires are permitted. The use of natural gas or propane are permissible unless a Red Flag Warning is issued then No Open Flame of any kind allowed.
- Do Not feed the wildlife.
- Keep food securely stored and not accessible by animals.
- Dispose all trash in designated receptacles.
- Registered campers are responsible for all persons associated with their campsite.
- Any disregard for these or other posted rules of the campground may result in loss of camping privileges. (See zero tolerance policy)
- Report any concerns or problems to campground staff or hosts.
  - For emergencies call 9-1-1 (threat to life and safety)
