

U.S. HIGHWAY 50 SOUTH LAKE TAHOE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

City of South Lake Tahoe "Y" to Trout Creek Bridge

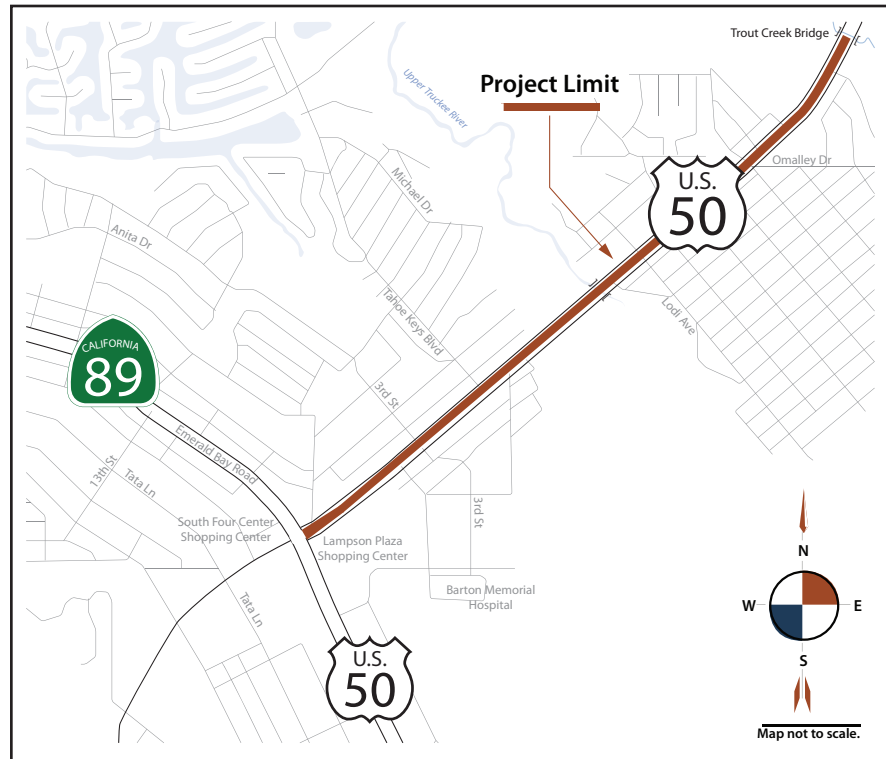
Project Benefits:

Within the City of South Lake Tahoe on U.S. Highway 50 (Lake Tahoe Boulevard) from the "Y" intersection with State Highway 89 to Trout Creek Bridge (2 miles), this estimated \$57 million project will collect and treat storm water runoff as part of the Lake Tahoe Environmental Improvement Program (EIP). Other project benefits include:

- Widening the roadway to provide 6-foot shoulders on each side for Class II bike lanes and widen bus pullouts.
- Repaving the roadway and improve the roadway cross slope.
- Reconstructing curb and gutter, driveways and sidewalks to ADA standards.
- Upgrading intersection signals at 3rd Street, Tahoe Keys Boulevard, Sierra Boulevard, and Rubicon Trail/O'Malley Drive and construct a new signal at Lodi Avenue.
- Adding a right-turn lane at Tahoe Keys Boulevard and a designated left-turn lane at Sierra Boulevard to improve traffic operations.

Schedule Dates:

2017-2019 (3 seasons) May 1 through October 15.



2018 Construction Area:

- Highway 50 from Winnemucca Avenue to Silver Dollar Avenue and repaving the "Y" Intersection.

Traffic Management:

Labor Day to Memorial Day (Off-Peak Season):

- The contractor must provide one traffic lane in each direction of travel from midnight Sunday to 11 a.m. Friday. No lane closures allowed from 11 a.m. Friday to midnight Sunday.

Memorial Day to Labor Day (Peak Season):

- The contractor must provide two traffic lanes in each direction from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday. From 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Friday, one lane in each direction must be provided. No lane closures from 8 a.m. Friday to midnight Sunday.
